1. Check Credits Assigned for Every Class.

- 1.1. The credits posted are determined by the number of credits for each class in the Master Schedule. The credits for a Year long class should be the number of credits earned for a year. Semester classes should be the number earned for one semester.
- 1.2. This report shows the marking periods and credits for every class in the Master Schedule. Check carefully, especially if classes have been changed from a year class to a semester class or semester to year.

2. Check Grading Scales

- 2.1. The number of points posted for a grade for a class is determined by the Grading Scale assigned to the section in the Master Schedule or in the student's course enrollment if the student has an individually assigned grading scale.
- 2.2. Classes with Pass/Fail grading scales or others with no point values need to be set to not be included in GPA. This is done in the Master Schedule section.

3. Check Settings for Weighted Courses

- 3.1. The Yes/No setting for Weighted Grade Point Course is in the Course Master and the Master Schedule. The one used when posting to transcripts is in the Master Schedule.
